ANSWERS

1. What was Mole doing at the beginning of the story?

Mole was (very busy) cleaning his (little) home.

2. How do you think Mole felt when he left his hole? Choose two feelings from the list.

Any reasonable answers, e.g. happy, excited, nervous, relaxed.

3. What do you think Mole could see in the meadow? What sounds could he hear? Make a list.

Any reasonable answers, e.g.:

Mole could see...

...**grass**

...**flowers**

...**trees**

...**sunshine**

Mole could hear...

...**birds singing**

...**the wind blowing**

...**the river babbling**

...**insects humming**

4. Who did Mole meet at the end of the story? Where did he meet him?

Mole met (the Water) Rat by the river.

Can you put these events in the order you think they happen?

Answer:

1. Rat invites Mole on a picnic.

2. Mole says "Yes please!"

3. Rat packs the picnic basket.

4. They row down the river to find a nice spot.

5. They eat the picnic.

6. After the picnic, they start to row home.

7. Mole falls in the river!

8. Rat saves Mole.

9. They go home to dry off.
